

OUR NEXT MEETING

POLISH DOWSING

Dowsing has many years of tradition in Poland. The first mention of it was about Jan Grelich, a blind dowser from Poznan. He found thieves with the help of his dowsing rod in 1450. Some Polish kings promoted dowsing.

Dowser A. Giedro-Podebranski was employed by King Stanislaw August Poniatowski (1764-1795) to find the deposits of minerals. His dowsing work was successful and very famous at the time. Wellbuilders in Poland commonly used the rod to detect underground watercourses and springs.

During the First World War Dr. Kazimierz Radwan-Pragłowski, who then became a famous dowser and psychologist, was hired by the head- quarters of the Austrian army to detect hidden mines with rods, as well as ammunition depots. He was also the author of the first dowsing hand- book published in Poland in 1922. Leszek Matela, is a well-known Polish dowser, journalist and author of 63 books in the field of radiesthesia, geomancy and nature therapy.

HAVING A FRIENDLY CHAT

One of the exciting aspects of dowsing is the unknown directions you'll be taken. This is especially true if you listen to your intuitions or prompts and simply follow them. Developing that intuitive sense may not come easily but it's well worthwhile.

So here we were, receiving prompts about talking to all sorts of things. It led to us starting a conversation with just about anything - a tree, an ant, a cockatoo, a car, or a gold nugget. The biggest mistake was expecting to receive back a whole set of words in our heads. That just didn't happen.

Months went past and we couldn't find anything that wanted to have a conversation. Very disappointing. Until there was a prompt that just made sense. The word 'ask' just popped in. So we asked a few objects if they wanted to have a conversation and very quickly received a 'Yes' and that was the key. All that was needed was to ask a simple dowsing question that would produce a Yes/No response. Then the conversations took off. It's just important to remember the thing you are talking to will generally reply with either a 'Yes' or a 'No'.

You are using a dowsing question to communicate from your higher self to the higher self of anything else and then you're receiving Yes/No answers.

We've always found keeping an open mind and asking lots of questions to be a good approach. The universal consciousness is always there to answer questions.

USEFUL DOWSING TIPS

Before Raymon Grace begins to dowse he uses straight-forward Yes/No dowsing to ask if he can help a person (or possibly an animal or situation). If the answer is a Yes, he then he asks whether there is any reason not to. With Yes responses in place, he then goes ahead.

He's said in the past that it's not always easy to identify what a particular problem is. He simply trusts it because, even if he doesn't know himself, he is confident that his dowsing system does know.

When he goes ahead with his dowsing Raymon just trusts in the outcome. The first key to dowsing is Intention. The second is the Expectation that it will work.
